

CRIMINAL SCREENING INELIGIBILITY PROFILE

Convictions or pending indictments for the following crimes will be treated as indicated for the time period indicated. In multiple offenses or combinations of crimes, the 2nd column applies to each crime.

Persons with an outstanding Warrant are ineligible as long as warrant exists.

Manufacturing of Methamphetamines on premises of Federally-Assisted Housing results in permanent ineligibility for assisted housing.

Sex offenders subject to lifetime registration are permanently ineligible.

Ineligibility period starts from last; date of incarceration, probation, arrest, etc.
